Please note: The course selection process begins with curriculum night, January 10, 2024. All current FCPS students can select their courses in SIS StudentVUE. Each student will be provided scheduled time to meet with his/her/their counselor. Changes on those selections can be made through March 6, 2024. Student Services spends considerable time assisting students with their selection of appropriate courses. Since all decisions regarding staffing, instructional supplies, etc. are made based on those selections, schedule change requests after March 6, 2024 may only be accommodated under very limited circumstances and may not be possible due to space availability. Courses dropped after 1st quarter will receive a "WP" or "WF." Pass/fail and Audit options require additional forms and have deadlines prior and early in the quarter.

Possible changes to course selection may occur for three main reasons. (1) Students may be placed in support classes based on end of year progress and assessments. (2) If a course is canceled or overenrolled, the alternate course will automatically take its place. (3) Similarly, if there is a conflict with another course, we will automatically select the alternate course over the summer. Course selection can be viewed on SIS ParentVUE and StudentVUE.

Ask your counselor if summer school or online classes are applicable and make sure you follow through with the proper registration.
