What Colleges Want From Applicants

Strong academic record

- Students who have completed the most challenging course of study appropriate for their abilities, including a rigorous senior year schedule
- Students who have taken four years of "core" classes
- Improvement over the high school years
- Solid standardized test performance (SAT and/or ACT)

Extracurricular, Athletic, and Community Involvement

- Colleges are seeking students who demonstrate a variety of interests and a connection to the world around them
- "Quality vs. Quantity"

Well-prepared application package – required demographic forms, essays/personal statements, and teacher/counselor recommendations

 It is very important to get to know a few of your teachers and your high school counselor so that you can get good recommendations for college
