- Students must achieve satisfactory scores on placement tests or SATs as established by NVCC
- Students must complete the application process at NVCC
- Student must submit a parent permission form as part of the enrollment process

College Credit

DE English (con't.)

Expectations

- Students must purchase the textbooks--one for each semester.
- Success in this class requires the ability to learn independently and complete work on time.
- Students will need 2-4 hours weekly for homework—to include reading and writing.

Detailed Course Description

ENG 111 & 112 will prepare students to write in academic and professional contexts. Students will apply the writing process to generate ideas, organize their thoughts, draft texts in various genres and modes (e.g., digital and print), and revise, proofread, and edit to improve writing. Students will produce texts that reflect critical thinking and knowledge of active reading and rhetorical situations. Students will develop information literacy, learning to use traditional and digital technologies to conduct introductory research.
